The Background Runtime Service (BRS) is an integral part of the functionality of Cora SeQUENCE. BRS is a Windows service that includes several threads. Each of these threads is responsible for performing one of the following actions:

- Redirect workflows
- Send emails
- Control workflow status
- Execute the Database Listener activity
- Calculate workflow statistics
- Sync work with other BRS instances
- Clean the table of temporary attachments
- Move closed process instances to separate tables
- Create reminders
- Resume workflow execution

Each of the above threads includes configuration options, such as how often and when to perform the action.
