A data model consists of queries that connect to various data sources. There are several query types.

Query Types

Query Type	Description
Tables	UACT tables in the Cora SeSequence database.
Lookup Tables	Tables with lookup values that you can use in various several controls, such as combo boxes, option groups, and grids.
Stored Procedures	Procedures that return data from the default Cora SeSequence database or through a connection string, based on input parameters.
Services	Calls to external service methods, Web services, or WCF services to retrieve data.
Files	Copies data from a file, which you can use as a data model. Supported file types are CSV, Open XML, and XML.
