

# Error Message When You Create or Edit a Schema in a REST Consumer

## Description

When you create or edit a schema in a REST Consumer Activity, you receive the following error message.

```
"...RadAsyncUpload could not create App_Data folder..."
```

## Cause

Cora SeQuence users or services do not have sufficient permission to create folders or files to the `App_Data` main folder.

## Affected Versions

8.3 and later.

## Solution

1. Grant full permissions to the `iis_users` group contained in the application pool user to the folder in the following path.

```
C:\inetpub\wwwroot\[administration site folder name]\Administration\
```

2. Add the following folders to `C:\inetpub\wwwroot\[administration site folder name]\Administration\`.

- o `App_Data`
- o `App_Data\RadUploadTemp`
