

# Flowtime Does Not Display Properly on Mobile Devices

## Description

Flowtime site and forms load properly on desktop browsers, but do not load properly on mobile devices. Some common issues include:

- Missing Flowtime grids
- Missing CSS
- JavaScript is not running
- Remote debugging displays errors, such as:

```
Refused to execute script from  
'https://flowdev.mycompany.com/Shared%20Resources/js/jquery/jqueryInclude.js' because its MIME  
type ('text/html') is not executable, and strict MIME type checking is enabled.....  
Uncaught ReferenceError: $sq is not defined .....
```

## Cause

SharePoint applies its own mobile view policy, which conflicts with Cora Sequence behavior.

## Affected Versions

All versions with Flowtime on SharePoint.

## Solution

There are two solutions.

- Deactivate the Mobile View feature in SharePoint by navigating to **Flowtime > Site Settings > Manage site features > Locate Mobile Browser View > Deactivate.**
- For mobile device access, instead of using Flowtime, use Process<sup>TOGO</sup>, which is a lighter runtime application designed specifically for mobile devices.
