

Cora SeSequence 8.5.4 Release Notes

This is an update for Cora SeSequence v8.5.0, which resolves several product issues, detailed below.

Resolved Issues

- **The Display Name property in the Email Listener Activity returns null.**

Resolution: The Email Listener code was fixed.

- **In the Team Leaders work assignments board, case title displays instead of task subject.**

Resolution: Tile parameters were modified.

- **JES service fails on start when *always encrypted* is configured.**

Resolution: Declare User Type when calling the database procedures.

- **You cannot use the *Quick Add Employee* option in the Organization Management wizard when *always encrypted* is configured..**

Resolution: Declare User Type when calling the database procedures.

- ***AlternateMail* is not synched to the *fldEmail* field when provisioning users from Azure AD..**

Resolution: If there is no email property for the user, the Azure AD Synchronization Service retrieves the first item in the *AlternateEmails* property. If there is no value in the *AlternateEmails* field, the *MailNickName* property is retrieved.

Update Steps

Update from 8.5.3:

1. Back up your Cora SeSequence database.
2. Run the `PatchSynchronization_Data.sql` script from the DB Scripts folder on your Cora SeSequence database.
3. Run IISReset.
4. Make sure the following files and folders are on the same level in the server.
 - o `Administration`
 - o `GAC`
 - o `Shared Resources`
 - o `exe.bat`
 - o `PatchTo8_5_4.ps1`
5. Run the `exe.bat` file as Administrator on all Cora SeSequence servers.
6. Run IISReset for the change to take effect.

NOTE: Only Sequence 8.5.6.0 Cumulative Update is available for download. If you are running a Cora SeSequence version earlier than v8.5.3, you must install v8.5.3 before you install v8.5.4.
