This is an update for Cora SeSequence V8.6, which includes a fix for the issue detailed below.

Resolved issue

An XSS security breach was solved.

Update steps

Updating from V8.6.2.2

1. Back up your Cora SeSequence database.
2. Back up the following files:
 - o In the Administration site:
 - `bin\PNMsoft.Sequence.Studio.dll`
 - o In the Flowtime site:
 - `GAC\PNMsoft.Sequence.Runtime.Web.UI.dll`

NOTE

Make sure that you save the backed up files in a different folder, such as the desktop.

3. [Download](#) the ZIP file.
4. Open the **DB Scripts** folder, and run the following script on your Cora SeSequence database:
 - o `PatchSynchronization_Data.sql`
5. Make sure the following files and folders are in the same level on the server.
 - o `Engine`
 - o `SequencePatch.xml`
 - o `SequencePatcher.ps1`
6. Run `SequencePatcher.ps1` file as Administrator on **all** Cora SeSequence servers.
 - a. Right click `SequencePatcher.ps1` , and then select **Run with PowerShell**.

Rollback steps

1. Restore the Cora SeSequence database to previous state.
2. Restore the backed up files.

NOTE

If you are running a Cora SeSequence version earlier than V8.6.2.2, you need to upgrade to V8.6.2.2 before you install V8.6.3.
