Update steps

Updating from V8.8.1.1.

- 1. Back up your Cora SeQuence database.
- 2. Back up the following files:
 - In the Administration site, bin\PNMsoft.Sequence.Studio.dll.
 - $\verb| o In all servers, in the GAC, \verb| PNMsoft.Sequence.HotOperations.dll| . \\$

NOTE

Make sure that you save the backed up files in a different folder, such as the desktop.

- 3. Download the ZIP file.
- 4. Open the **DB Scripts** folder, and run the following script on your Cora SeQuence database:
 - O PatchSynchronization_Data.sql
- 5. Make sure the following files and folders are in the same level on the server.
 - O Engine
 - O SequencePatch.xml
 - O SequencePatcher.ps1
- 6. Right click | SequencePatcher.ps1 | , and then select Run with PowerShell.

Rollback steps

- 1. Restore the Cora SeQuence database to previous state.
- 2. Restore the backed up files.

NOTE

If you are running a Cora SeQuence version earlier than V8.8.1.1, you need to install V8.8.1.1 before you install V8.8.1.2.
