Sets the configuration for a specific type of application. If not provided, configuration is set on all the installed apps.

#### -ApplicationID <Int32>

The numeric ID for a specific instance of the application type to set. Ignored if AllInstances is used.

#### -AllInstances [<SwitchParameter>]

Sets the configuration for all instances of the specified application.

Required?	false
Position?	named
Default value	False
Accept pipeline input?	false

#### <CommonParameters>
