CoraSeQuence

Description

Checks Cora SeQuence compatibility with the operating system. This function returns a hashtable with the keys:

| Key       | Value  |
|-----------|--|
| Supported | true/false   |
| Message   | Error message, if the operating system is not compatible with Cora SeQuence. |

Test-CoraSeQuenceCompatibility [<CommonParameters>]
```
