CoraSeQUENCE.Sites

Description

Uninstalls a Cora SeQUENCE site.

Syntax

```
Uninstall-CoraSeQUENCESite [-SiteType] <Object> [[-SiteID] <Int32>] [<CommonParameters>]
```

Parameters

-SiteType <Object>

Determines which Cora SeQUENCE site is uninstalled: Flowtime or Administration or WebAPI.

-SiteID <Int32>

The numeric ID of the site instance.
